

Uniform Articulation Agreement

North Carolina graduates of an Associate in Applied Science in Nursing will fall under the RN to BSN Uniform Articulation Agreement, jointly approved by the NC Community College and the University of North Carolina Systems. Eligibility for the Uniform Articulation Agreement, a potential student must:

- Enter a NC Community College Nursing program **on or after Fall Semester, 2015**
- Earn an Associate Degree in Nursing at a NC Community College with a GPA of at least 2.0
- Earn a C or better in all courses included in the first three blocks of the plan.
- Be licensed as an RN prior to applying to the RN to BSN program.

Block 1 (23 credits) — Consists of certain prerequisite nursing courses that are part of all North Carolina Community College AAS Nursing programs. The courses are:

Block 2 (18-19 credits) — Consists of additional university general education requirements that are **not** part of an AAS degree, but are required to earn a BSN. BSN requirements will be met by completing **one** listed course in each of the first four categories and **two** in the last.

Block 3 (17-18 credits) — Consists of additional nursing or other requirements that are not part of an AAS degree, but **are required** to earn a BSN.

Block 4 (30 credits) — Consists of credit awarded after completion of one semester at WPU
